White fillings

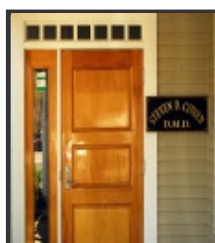
White or tooth-colored fillings offer more than a natural pleasing look. Tooth colored fillings require the removal of less tooth structure than metal fillings. They are also strongly bonded to your tooth with a thin layer of adhesive. Like any other type of restoration, white fillings, called composites, can cause increased sensitivity to hot and cold foods for up to two weeks.

Tooth-colored fillings, also called composites, are ideal for front teeth or back teeth (figures 1 & 2) with small to moderate amounts of decay.



If the decay is large, or a significant amount of tooth structure is missing, the dentist may choose to restore a tooth with larger custom made filling, called onlays, or a dental crown. A white tooth colored filling is usually done in a single short dental visit and can last for many years.
