## Is Tooth Whitening for Me?

Though we all want a brighter smile, not all patients are instant candidates for teeth whitening. For the best possible results, we take the following steps to prepare a patient for tooth whitening:

1. A comprehensive dental exam is done to evaluate the teeth for any dental cavities and existing dental fillings.
2. The front teeth are evaluated for the types of stains present. Yellowish stained teeth usually bleach very well, while brownish or grey colored teeth may deliver lesser results. Tooth-colored fillings in the front teeth are not affected by bleaching, and may become visible after the tooth around them is whitened. Some of these fillings may need to be replaced after whitening.
3. A professional presentation helps to explain tooth whitening and cosmetic options and answer any concerns.
4. A professional dental cleaning is then done to remove dental plaque or tartar and prepare the teeth for bleaching.
5. The bleaching process chosen by you begins.
